

How to come to the conference and general information:

By plane from the Belgrade airport

There will be three transfers from the Airport to hotel on June 19th and June 24th. One in the morning, one early afternoon, and one late afternoon. Exact time will be determined to minimize waiting time. Therefore, please send us your flight numbers, arrival and departure time.

By plane from the Budapest airport

There is a chance that you can find much easier (and also cheaper) flight to the Budapest. By public transportation you can easily arrive to the East railroad station (Keleti pályaudvar). By train from Budapest East railroad station (Keleti pályaudvar).

There are 3 direct trains from Budapest to Novi Sad (8:05 (arrives 14:55), 12:05 (arrives 18:40) and 22:25 (arrives 4:48)). You can buy tickets online

By train from Vienna

There is one direct train from Vienna (8:42) via Budapest (12:05) to Novi Sad (18:40).

By train from direction of Zagreb

There is no direct train to Novi Sad, but you do not need to go all up to Belgrade. Step-down at Ruma. Next to the railway station is bus station. Take bus to Novi Sad. Price is around 300 dinars (less than 3 euros), and you have to pay in dinars. Most of the buses stops at Iriški venac, and after that you have to walk 4km. If you are arriving on Sunday afternoon, one of the organizers will already be at the hotel by car, so he can pick you up. Otherwise, you can go by bus up to the Novi Sad. Bus station is next to the railway station.

In front of Ruma railway station there are always several TAXI drivers which drives to Novi Sad. You can use them, and probably you can ask them to drive you directly to hotel (especially if you are arriving in group).

By bus from Budapest or Vienna.

Also there are several mini-bus lines from Vienna.

From Novi Sad railway (and bus) station to the Faculty of Sciences, Department of Mathematics and Informatics

You may take bus number 4, and after that by foot around 500m. Step-up station is just in front of the railway station, and step-down station, named "University campus" is when the bus turns to the right for the third time (check the map).

You can buy bus ticket in the bus and it costs 55 dinars (less than 50 euro-cents), but you will need dinars for that. There is an exchange office at the building in front of the station (about 200m away).

Also you may take TAXI from the TAXI station located next to the old steam-engine (to the left when you exit railway station building). Expected price should be less than 4 euros, and, and if you ask in advance, you can probably pay in euros (and expect change in dinars).

At the Faculty will be organized a place where you can leave luggage and comfortably wait for the transfer to hotel.

From the Faculty building to the hotel Norcev:

Transfer will be organized on June 19th (probably around 6 PM) and for the way back on June 24th around 9AM. Just be sure to send us expected arrival and departure time.

If there are several participants arriving by the same train from Budapest (Vienna), which comes to Novi Sad at 18:40, we can organize transfer to hotel directly from the railway station. Also, since this direct train to Vienna leaves Novi Sad at 9AM, this group can leave hotel around 8AM, and will be transferred directly to the railway station.

Currency:

Currently 1 euro =123 dinars.

Visas

Please check if you need a visa for entering Serbia.
